# **HUD Housing**

Our HUD properties provide various types of housing options, depending on an individual's need. Independent and supervised living arrangements are offered with the option of double occupancy rooms, one bedroom, and two bedroom apartments. Certain requirements must be met to be eligible for housing. Those requirements include income and disability and/or elderly persons.





#### **Havens — Madison County**

Houses individuals with a serious mental illness (SMI) diagnosis. Accommodations are either one or two individuals per apartment.



## Hartung — Madison County

Houses adults with a serious mental illness (SMI). The property provides supervised living and is staffed 24/7.



#### **Hudson** — Madison County

Houses adults with a serious mental illness (SMI). The property provides supervised living and is staffed 24/7.



#### National Place — Marion County

Houses individuals with a disability. Accommodations are one bedroom units.



# Pauley Glover — Marion County

Houses individuals who are mobility impaired. Accommodations are either one or two bedroom apartments.

Aspire proudly accepts and most commercial offer a sliding fee scale assist people in obtaining coverage.



#### **Questend — Marion County**

Houses adults with a serious mental illness (SMI). The property provides supervised living and is staffed 24/7.



# **Sunshine House — Marion County**

Houses adults with a serious mental illness (SMI). The property provides supervised living the majority of the day.
