

Mobile Clinic Services

Aspire Indiana Health is proud to provide mobile clinic services to select areas of Indianapolis. Funded by a generous grant from the city, the mobile clinic unit is primarily focused on serving those with substance use and/or mental health disorders and/or those who are experiencing homelessness.

Services

Nicknamed Macy – Mobile Access Care for You – the mobile clinic provides medical visits and assessments, with a focus on addressing

medical challenges for those who are unhoused, experiencing mental health challenges and/or substance abuse disorders.

Macy includes a wheelchair lift. Referrals will also be made for other Aspire services such as behavioral healthcare and substance use disorder treatment.

Payment

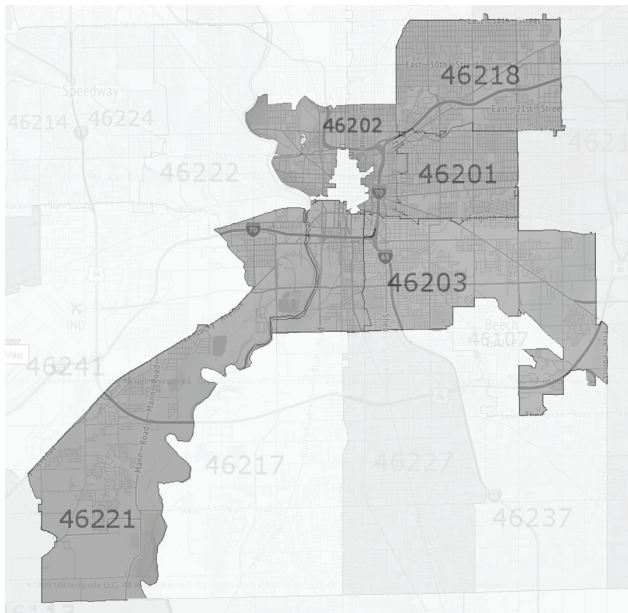
Medicaid and Medicare are accepted at the mobile unit as well as

most traditional insurance. Aspire also has low-cost sliding scale fees for those who are uninsured or underinsured, and can assist patients in applying for Medicaid coverage. **No one will be refused services for the inability to pay.**

Deployment

Macy the mobile clinic unit will be initially deployed three days a week to areas selected in partnership with City of Indianapolis officials to target communities hardest hit by mental health challenges, substance use disorder and a lack of adequate medical care.
