Aspire has a wide array of services for youth and family closely aligned with the goals of those we serve – to whenever possible keep children and families together in their homes and schools while obtaining the resources, assistance and interventions to function safely and adaptively with the challenges that arrive in their lives.

These services include:

- Family or individual therapy/skills training
- Intake assessments

- Primary medical care such as wellness appointments,
- Acute illness care, sports physicals, etc.

We collaborate with other entities that serve youth and families, including schools, law enforcement, judicial authorities, the Indiana Department of Child Services (DCS) and other governmental agencies. Working together, we have developed a comprehensive treatment platform to address the complex emotional, behavioral and mental health needs of families.

Community-Based Services

In addition to the services offered at our offices, Aspire also has a powerful community-based program of services. These are provided to clients in their homes or community that are a blend of individual and family counseling, skill development training and case management.

Community-based services are designed to assist families with a multitude of mental health needs and to strengthen their ability to effectively cope with their daily lives and responsibilities as contributing members of their community.
