



Affordable Housing

Aspire Indiana Health provides affordable housing to more than 100 individuals and families throughout Central Indiana.

We have built strong relationships with HUD, Indiana Housing and Community Development Authority (IHCDA), the city of Anderson Community and Economic Development, and the City of Indianapolis. Our affordable housing program has assisted individuals with HIV,

moderate housing barriers, severe and persistent mental illness, mobility impairment and those who are homeless.

HUD – Housing and Urban Development

We operate seven HUD properties in Madison and Marion Counties. These properties allow individuals who are disadvantaged to be housed based upon their income and medical expenses. Three of the properties operate as group homes. Group home settings include those with severe and persistent mental illness. We also operate Section 202 properties, which are independent living facilities.

There are one- and two-bedroom options where certain requirements – income and disability and/or elderly persons – must be met to be eligible for housing.

Co-op Property

Aspire manages one co-op property in Madison County. A co-op or cooperative living arrangement is where a resident has their own bedroom, but they share the common living spaces: bathroom, living room and kitchen.



Rental Properties

We operate several rental properties in Boone and Madison Counties. These properties are geared toward individuals who are homeless or at risk of homelessness. To help individuals maintain stable housing, we utilize various funding sources that provide wraparound supportive services.
