SUBJECT: 2025 Farrington Foundation Scholarship

Please find attached an application for the 2025 Farrington Foundation Scholarship Award. This \$5,000 scholarship, sponsored by the Farrington Foundation, was established by Ethel Farrington, a former public health officer and author.

This scholarship is open to tribally enrolled *high* school seniors who are enrolling in a four-year institution of higher learning upon completion of high school.

Recipients must be enrolled full-time for the fall semester of the 2025 school year, at a North Carolina state-supported four-year institution of higher education, and attain and maintain a grade point average of at least 3.0.

Funds will be distributed in \$2,500 increment distributions per semester for a total distribution of \$5,000. All funds will be available upon proof of enrollment and certification of grade point average.

The application must be submitted by May 2, 2025, by 5:00 pm. You may mail the application to P.O. Box 99, Hollister, North Carolina 27844, or deliver it to the Chief W. R. Richardson Tribal Government Complex.

- 2. *Tribal Enrollment:* Proof of your status as a member of the Haliwa-Saponi Indian Tribe Tribal (copy of enrollment card). (page 2 of 7)
- 3. Transcript. Your official transcript, is sealed and signed across the back closure by the reference source.
- 4. College Admission Verification: A Copy of a letter of admission/acceptance from a college or university. If the letter is not available, please make a notation and send it as soon as possible. No student will be awarded a scholarship until we have received a copy of the letter and we have proof of enrollment, i.e. billing statement, class list, etc. (page 2 of 7)
- 5. **Extra-Curricular Activities:** List all extracurricular activities in which you have participated. (Attach documentation, pictures, newspaper clipping, etc.); (page 3 of 7)
- 6. *Letters:* Two (2) letters of recommendation from teachers, counselors, professors, employers, elected officials, religious leaders, and/or mentors. (page 5 of 7)
 - i. Reference letters are to be individually placed in an envelope, sealed, and signed across the back closure by the reference source.
 - ii. Please *do not use* family members as references.
 - iii. Points will not be awarded if reference letters do not meet the above criteria.
- 7. Essay: An essay on one of the topics listed (page 4 of 7)
 - a. Essay must be no more than one page typed,
 - b. double-spaced with 1-inch margins
 - c. 12 pitch fonts, Arial or Times New Roman
