Quarterly Church Meeting

Wednesday, April 30, 6:30 p.m.

In addition to regular reports, the Personnel Committee will present a recommendation for approval that Ben Potter fill the role of the new ly formed position of FBC Monroe Ministry Apprentice. This ministry offers hands-on experience and membership in a specific ministry area, helping individuals grow in their calling and develop skills for future ministry roles, often through a combination of training and practical application. If approved, Ben will start May 1st with a 90 day review period with a 1 year apprenticeship to follow, which would be from September 1, 2025 to August 31, 2026. This will be no cost to the budget. Duties will include:

- 1. Coordinate and foster new opportunities for Christian Education;
- 2. Explore, create and curate intentional discipleship groups within the church;
- 3. Assist with miscellaneous tasks that contribute to the overall accessibility and reach of the church, such as website improvement, community networking, visitor outreach, etc.
- 5. Preach on an "as needed" basis, if asked; and
- 6. Help alleviate the burden of miscellaneous tasks that the Senior Pastor needs to delegate.
