## OVERVIEW OF SERVICES

Primary care and behavioral health services are provided in an Aspire health center, and behavioral health appointments may also be offered in a home, school or community-based setting. In addition, Aspire provides specialty medical services, including women’s health, children’s vaccines, rheumatology, dermatology and neurology.

**Primary Care** includes all the common aspects of family medicine including well checks, lab tests, prescriptions, pediatrics, elder care and more.

**Behavioral Care** includes treating children and adults of all ages whose behavior and functioning has been impaired by a variety of symptoms associated with depression, anxiety, substance use, thought disorder, adjustment to trauma and loss, as well as a host of other issues.

**Same Day Access (SDA)** hours are now available for new behavioral health patients. See the back of this flyer for more information.

**Integrated Care** means the information of the patient’s Primary Care and Behavioral Care is shared among team members to establish a comprehensive



treatment plan which will address the biological, psychological and social needs of the patient. The integrated healthcare team includes a diverse group of members (e.g., physicians, nurses, psychologists and other health professionals) tailored to the needs of the individual.
