OVERVIEW OF SERVICES

Primary care and behavioral health services are provided in an Aspire health center, and behavioral health appointments may also be offered in a home, school or community-based setting. In addition, Aspire provides specialty medical services, including women's health, children's vaccines, rheumatology, dermatology and neurology.

Primary Care includes all the common aspects of family medicine including well checks, lab tests, prescriptions, pediatrics, elder care and more.

Behavioral Care includes treating children and adults of all ages whose behavior and functioning has been impaired by a variety of symptoms associated with depression, anxiety, substance use, thought disorder, adjustment to trauma and loss, as well as a host of other issues.

Same Day Access (SDA) hours are now available for new behavioral health patients. See the back of this flyer for more information.

Integrated Care means the information of the patient's Primary Care and Behavioral Care is shared among team members to establish a comprehensive



treatment plan which will address the biological, psychological and social needs of the patient. The integrated healthcare team includes a diverse group of members (e.g., physicians, nurses, psychologists and other health professionals) tailored to the needs of the individual.
