Every Door Campaign

The App

Over the last year, we have been working with a mission partner, Santiago— who has been developing an app for our ministry. The app is a strategy tool to reach every door in America with the Gospel and eventually every door in the world. Over the last 10+ years, we have been knocking on doors during the grill walk and sharing the Gospel message with others. This has happened in dozens of towns in Oklahoma, and now in states all across America and South America as well. But up to this point, how do we keep track of where we have been? How do we know where our partnering churches have ministered? What neighborhoods? What doors? Now, through the app, we will have a way to map out, strategize, and keep track of the data from each door that is knocked on during any grill walk in the world. We will be able to record testimonies, salvations, prayer requests, and neighborhoods that have been covered. Now, we will be able to strategically cover areas that we haven't ministered to yet until every door is reached! Not only that, but church leaders will be able to save the data to use for follow ups after they do a grill outreach.

With this app as a tool, everything changes. The mission remains; to mobilize the church to reach the lost. But now, we can keep running forward with the mission with clarity, strategy, and accomplish what God gave us to do!

Strategy for International Missions



Send Relief Miami

The serve tour Miami was a powerful weekend. There were 40 salvations total! Send relief wrote "That afternoon, volunteers from Grace Connection joined a grill walk through their own neighborhood, loading a trailer with burgers, chips, and copies of the Gospel of John. What stayed with leaders wasn't just the response from neighbors, but what the experience stirred in the church itself. "When you see young adults, youth, and older folks serving together, the joy is unmistakable," said project leader Marlene Dordoye. "The joy we feel when we ring the bell for each person who accepts Christ, and the joy I see in the youth who are serving people, it brings joy to my heart." By the end of the afternoon, 28 people had prayed to receive Christ. Three other grill walks happened across Miami that Saturday. At one, a team approached a group of young men playing basketball. They offered burgers. The young men said yes. "We asked if they were certain of where they would spend eternity if they were to die today," said project leader Yohan McGlashan. "They were uncertain, and asked, 'How can we know for sure?'" The team shared the gospel. None of the young men prayed to receive Christ that day, but all of them agreed to pray. The group circled up at the free throw line, and one of the volunteers led a prayer over them. It was one of 40 gospel conversations that happened during that single grill walk.



On one grill walk, a UPS driver drove by at the perfect time. Jeremiah asked him about where he would go if he died and he didn't know. All his friends influenced him to different religions. After hearing the real Gospel, he said "That's what I want." and he gave his life to Jesus right there. The car directly behind him ended up being a drug dealer. When asked where he would go when he dies he said he is certainly going to hell. He said he's open to anything. So that day, he heard the true Gospel, was moved by it, and surrendered to Jesus in his car. Both those cars were there at God's sovereign and perfect timing. At another grill walk, a pair of twins heard the Gospel and surrendered their lives to Jesus. Not only were they changed, but they were already on fire for Jesus! They excitedly joined and helped on the grill walks right after they said yes to Jesus.
