## WHAT CAN I EXPECT DURING MY FIRST APPOINTMENT?

After completing registration paperwork, you will receive a preliminary screening to gather basic information and help us determine your primary treatment needs. Depending on your needs, our trained pre-assessment team member will connect you with the most appropriate services. If you are in need of a comprehensive assessment, you will then meet with an intake clinician to complete a comprehensive evaluation of your symptoms, provide an initial diagnosis, and develop a personalized treatment plan with recommendations for care.

This overall process typically lasts 90-120 minutes, but can be shorter or longer, so please plan accordingly. You may experience wait times. It is not recommended that parents bring children to the parent's intake. However, children are required to attend intake appointments for their own services.
