## Send Relief: Birmingham, AL

For one of the Serve Tour stops with Send Relief, part of the team traveled to Birmingham, Alabama. The team helped setup for the Serve Tour for the first 2 days of the trip. They did a total of six grill walks in six different areas of Birmingham during the two days of outreaches. They had a total of 51 salvations, praise the Lord! For the first outreach, Jeremiah led a grill walk team along with Todd from Kansas, with volunteers from Alabama, Kentucky, Virginia, Mississippi, and Cincinnati. Hayden and Brandon also led two more grill teams in other areas of Birmingham.

In the trailer park where Jeremiah took his first grill walk group, three police cars rushed into the area right as they arrived. Their sirens were blaring and it was chaos as they came in. The police officers told them there was a lot going on in the house where they were responding. During all that, some volunteers from the Hispanic church led a man to the Lord, Praise God! AS they finished up there, they saw that the officers had left, so they went straight to that door to minister.

Unexpectedly, an old woman opened the door and instantly pulled their arms in and started crying on their shoulders. When they asked if she knew Jesus, she responded that she had never even heard of that name. So after hearing the Gospel, she was ready to accept Jesus as her savior. It was God's sovereignty that she heard the Gospel in her moment of distress.

A Volunteer asked Jeremiah to go and meet a couple. They ended up sharing about how they're new believers and they are part of an evangelism class and were challenged this week to go out and try it with a tract. The lady said how they were terrified and discouraged. So it opened the opportunity for Jeremiah to teach them how to evangelize. After Jeremiah prayed for God to send someone for them to talk to, a lady pulled up in a car to a trash bin nearby. So the terrified couple and Jeremiah went up and shared the Gospel with her and she started weeping, and she eventually wanted to say yes to Jesus. The woman who was

trying to evangelize led her to the Lord and everyone was in tears. The Holy Spirit gave them the perfect moment an person to minister to intervene in Satan trying to bring fear to stop them from evangelizing. Praise God!

Hayden shares A testimony: "As I was walking along a trailer park with mostly Hispanics who only spoke Spanish, we stumbled upon a trailer with a few people outside. At first, they were very open to the burgers, but had a faint curiosity as to why we were there. Once the conversation progressed, [we] asked the question, "If you were to die today, where would you go? (Heaven or hell)". A couple I 'don't knows' and some questioning faces brought forth a conversation that ended up leading one man to the Lord. However, in the midst of all of this, there was one lady sitting in the back of the group that hadn't said much... before we left we had noticed her, and personally asked her the question. She said "I'd probably go to hell." With that response in mind we shared the gospel with her and she gave her life to Jesus as well."

Kasey shares A testimony: "-A team knocked on a door and met a young gentleman in his young twenties in a wheelchair. As they got talking to him, they found out he was a dad of a six year old and had been shot around a year ago in an act of gang violence. He then opened up that he wanted to change his lifestyle for his son and he had been seeking many different religions and had even tried talking to God and gotten as far as crying out to him for answers. The team was able to share the simple gospel and help him find what he had been looking for. The young man broke and gave his life to the Lord. We were able to connect him to the local church right then and there"

We praise God for moving mightily in Birmingham, Alabama! Not only through salvations but also through empowering so many churches to be the hands and feet of Jesus!

## Spring Break Mission Teams

This year during spring break we had the joy of hosting 2 mission teams from Owasso, OK and Kansas. The week was full of serving meals to businesses, painting murals of hope, Vacation Bible Schools, Grocery packing and delivering, grill walks, Community Movie Nights, and more! The teams all had a blast. Owasso stayed for 2 days and Kansas stayed for five. While both teams were here, there was a total of 50 people serving with us. The week was impactful for many of the kids. During an evening debrief, we heard the students share that they had prayed for someone for the first time, led people to the Lord for the first time, and many of them were in tears as they talked about people rejecting the good news of Jesus.

While the Kansas and Owasso teams were staying and working with us for local outreaches, we had a neighborhood block party. We went door-knocking and invited the kids out to play after offering free hotdogs. At one of the doors that a group of youth kids went up to, they met a hurting young man who lived there. The kids shared the simple gospel with him and a seventeen year-old that was part of the group took the opportunity to offer the man a time and a friend to help lead him in surrendering his heart to Christ. The man did, and three of the kids came running and skipping to the grill telling us the good news. The Lord was able to use this boy to show his peers the power of sharing the gospel and how He can use anybody for His work as long as they were willing.

After a long day of multiple outreaches, the teams set up our movie screen in our garden. We brought out popcorn, kool-aid, hotdogs on a grill, and a craft table.

We played the movie David while everybody hung out and enjoyed the time together and the neighborhood kids sat on the grass around me and the youth of the mission teams. When the movie was almost over, a group of little kids were asking me who the characters were in the movie, trying to figure out if they've heard this bible story before. This simply led to the simple gospel of how much Jesus loves them. This mission team youth were able to see how receptive and eager kids can be to hearing the true and simple story.

## BGCT Conference
