## Grill Outreach Training in Montana

Tristan and Hayden traveled to Livingston, Montana, to spend the weekend training Expedition Church and serving alongside them. Expedition Church has several church plants across Montana, and the team was invited to help equip them in practical outreach. On Saturday, they joined the church in completing three different yard cleanups around the community, working with volunteers and getting to know the heart of the church.

On Sunday, Tristan and Hayden spoke to the congregation and then led the church through a Grill Walk training, helping them learn how to share the Gospel in their own community one door at a time. The outreach took place in a trailer park in Livingston, where one woman gave her life to Jesus, and the team also had the opportunity to talk with a Hispanic family about the Gospel. Reflecting on the weekend, Hayden shared, "We're really impressed and we think God's gonna do a lot here... be praying for this church and be praying for everything that God has them do." It was a meaningful weekend of partnership, encouragement, and seeing God at work in Montana.

At Forgotten Ministries, we believe every act of service opens a door for the Gospel to be shared. There are so many ways to get involved and make a tangible difference right here in Enid. On the first Saturday of every month, volunteers gather for our Grocery Distribution from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. at 1714 S. 4th St. (Main Center)—arrive an hour early to help prepare, and stay until every neighbor is served.

You can also join us for our Community Garden workdays on the last Saturday of each month from 3–5 p.m., or help with the Mobile Clothes Closet that same day from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. Both take place at the Main Center and offer hands-on ways to bless families in need.

Every Tuesday evening at 6 p.m., we head to Don Haskins Park by St. Mary's Hospital for our Park Outreach, bringing food, fellowship, and the love of Jesus to the community.

Each opportunity is a chance to serve, connect, and see God move through simple acts of compassion. Whether you're handing out groceries, tending the garden, or praying with someone at the park, your presence matters. Together, we're answering His call to serve "the least of these" and share His love with every heart in our city.
