We've been serving Hoosiers for more than half a century. As an Indiana-chartered Community Mental Health Center (CMHC), we're entrusted with being the state's "official" provider of mental health services in six counties: Marion, Hamilton, Boone, Madison, Hancock and Shelby.

Aspire practices fully integrated "whole health" care, meaning we emphasize the connection between your physical and mental health.

We treat children and adults of all ages whose behavior and quality of life has been impaired by depression, anxiety, thought disorder, substance use, trauma and other issues such as housing and employment. If necessary, we'll refer you to other members of our team for additional help who will collaborate with each other on building a comprehensive treatment plan.

Effective treatment begins with a comprehensive assessment. Your first visit will be with a clinician



specifically trained to assess the challenges that prompted you to seek help. They will ask how key areas of your life are functioning and then develop a personalized plan for making a change.

The Aspire approach to care involves a number of clinical services in order to provide a "whole health" perspective of care that's tailored to each individual's needs. You may encounter Licensed Clinical Social Workers, Licensed Mental Health Counselors, Psychiatrists, Medical Practitioners, Psychologists, Care Coordinators, Advanced Practice Nurses and more.

Treatment may include services such as individual therapy, group therapy, family therapy, medication evaluations, care coordination and life skills instruction.

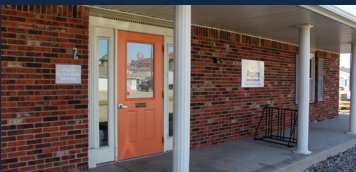
