Aspire Indiana Health provides housing services to hundreds of individuals and families throughout Central Indiana. We have the core belief that housing is healthcare because a safe, stable, and affordable home is the foundation for physical and mental well-being. While instability or poor quality housing directly causes and worsens illnesses, increasing healthcare needs and costs.



Our Housing Services team will conduct assessments to identify housing stability, resources available, and eligibility for federal, state, and local housing programs. After the assessments are complete, our team will come alongside individuals to create a plan to help individuals meet their housing goals.
