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International: Honduras Scout Trip

Tristan, Autumn, and their youngest son, Noah, spent last week in Honduras building relationships and laying the groundwork for future ministry. From the moment they arrived, God began opening doors—connecting them with pastors, translators, and leaders who shared a deep desire to see the Gospel reach their communities. They met with churches in La Ceiba and Tela whose members were already actively serving the poor, discipling children, and praying over some of the most vulnerable neighborhoods in their cities. Hearing their passion for evangelism and seeing entire teams committed to missions encouraged the family deeply. It was clear that God had already been stirring hearts long before they arrived.

Throughout the week, they shared the vision for the 2027 outreach and were met with enthusiasm, unity, and readiness. Pastors expressed a longing to return to the simple, powerful model of the early church—taking the Gospel to the streets with love, testimony, and boldness. The team prayed over neighborhoods, met families, and even had spontaneous Gospel conversations along the roadside, trusting that seeds were planted and that God would continue to work. As their time in Honduras came to a close, they left with gratitude and anticipation. The connections made, the unity of heart, and the openness of the churches all pointed to one truth: God is preparing something beautiful for next year, and they cannot wait to return and see His Spirit move in even greater ways.



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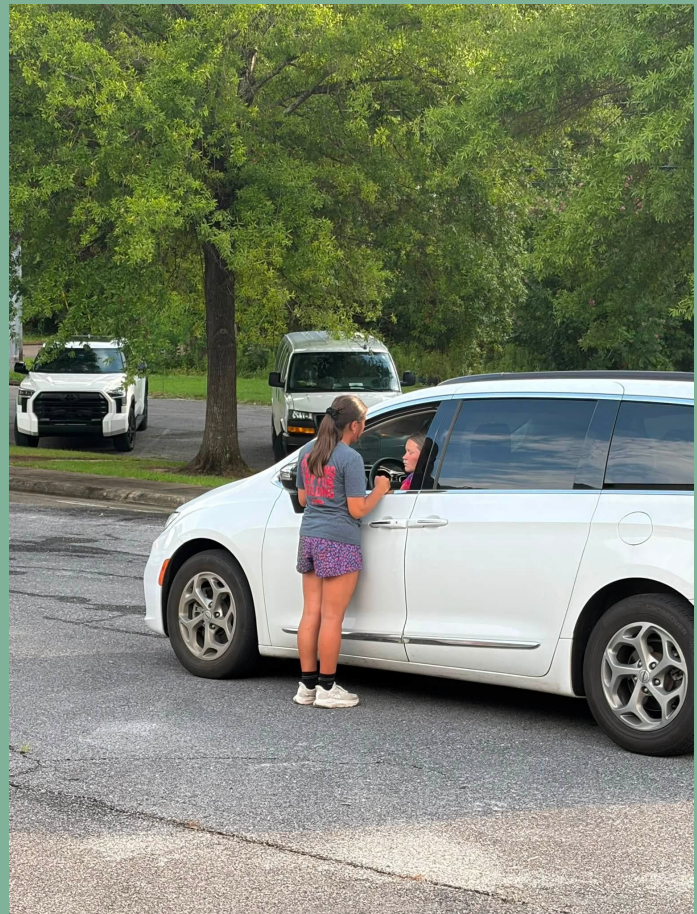
Love Out Loud - Meridian, MS

The Forgotten Ministries team embarked on a week-long outreach in Meridian, Mississippi, serving alongside local churches during the annual Love Out Loud event. Their partnership with leaders in Meridian—Gary and Cheryl Newell, and Rhonda—has grown over several years, beginning with a Serve Tour through Send Relief and continuing through ongoing grill outreaches and a clothing trailer ministry that have already led hundreds to salvation. This year, the team trained volunteers daily to conduct lunchtime grill walks across multiple apartment complexes and assisted with evangelism during evening grocery giveaways. The unity among the churches, the eagerness of volunteers, and the openness of the community created an atmosphere where the Gospel was received with joy. By the end of the week, they witnessed an incredible total of 213 salvations, each one a reminder of God's power to transform lives.

Throughout the outreaches, the team saw God move in personal and unforgettable ways. People responded to the Gospel at their doorsteps, in parking lots, and even while sitting in their cars. Linda recommitted her life to Christ while sitting on her porch. A mother carrying the weight of caring for multiple special-needs children surrendered her burdens to Jesus and found hope. Journey, a young woman who had never heard what Jesus accomplished on the cross, accepted salvation the moment she understood the truth. A young mom and her pregnant sister chose to follow Jesus so they could lead their families into a better future. These stories were only a glimpse of what God did throughout the week. As the team concluded their time in Meridian, they praised the Lord for every soul saved and prayed that the boldness of the church would continue—believing that God will keep transforming lives in Meridian long after Love Out Loud has ended.
