What does the future for Grace look like? Three different pathways will be explored.

- **Sunday, January 19**, our guest pastor will be Rev. Greg Stamm, newly appointed Leader for the Great Lakes City Classis who will present a message on the potential future path of Renewal and Revitalization for Grace Church followed by a question and answer time.
- **Tuesday, January 21**, a 90 minute presentation by Pastors Chris DeVos from Pillar Church on the path of revitalization for Pillar Church the ups and downs, the barriers they faced, etc. followed by question and answer time.
