### AFFORDABLE HOUSING

We provide housing and assistance to hundreds of individuals and families in more than 30 counties throughout Central Indiana. We have built strong relationships with HUD, Indiana Housing and Community Development, United Way and City of Anderson Community and Economic Development. Our housing programs have assisted individuals with HIV, moderate housing barriers, severe and persistent mental illness, mobility impairment, and those who are homeless.

## **HUD** - Housing and Urban Development

We operate six HUD properties in Madison and Marion Counties. These properties allow individuals who are disadvantaged to be housed based upon their income and medical expenses. Four of the six properties operate as group homes. Group home settings include those with severe and persistent mental illness. Please call for more information or a referral. The remaining two are Section 202 properties, Apartment Living and Pauley Glover. These properties provide individuals an independent living environment with a one or two bedroom apartment options. Certain requirements must be met to qualify. Those requirements include income and disability and/or elderly persons.

### **Co-op Property**

Aspire manages one co-op property (cooperative living arrangements) that houses anywhere from five to nine individuals. While each individual has their own bedroom, they share these common living spaces: bathroom, living room, and kitchen. Monthly rent varies from \$315 to \$325 per month and includes utilities. A security deposit, equal to one month's rent, is required.


#### **Rental Properties**
