



GROCERY DISTRIBUTION

We are currently delivering grocery and toiletry bags to approximately 200 households per month. At a cost of about \$10 USD each they are currently receiving 3 lbs. Flour, 3 lbs. Cornmeal, 3 lbs. Sugar, 3 lbs. Rice, Roll of Toilet Paper, Bar of Soap, Powdered Milk, Tin Mackerel, Tin Corned Beef, Bag of Crackers, and a gospel tract and contact information for any questions, counseling or prayer needs. Our team is working to enlarge the bags and extend the list of items received. Baby and Infant formula will also be added for those specific households.



DISCIPLESHIP

Currently FFMI Missionaries are developing a discipleship program that is biblically sound and culturally conducive to Jamaica. Such program will be utilized in a one-on-one association, as well as in group settings.

Monthly, we host an Evangelistic Men's luncheon in Bogue, where we share with them some incredible Caribbean food, but more importantly the goodness of God's love.

In addition, FFMI has been invited to visit Emmanuel's House and Noah's Ark, two boys' homes located in Portobello and Falmouth with the intention of implementing our discipleship program for boys up to the age of 19.

PASTORAL CARE

There are at least six Pastors currently without a home. Even in this condition they continue to be faithful shepherds. It is our desire to assure that they have a safe and secure place to call home.

HARVEST HOUSE VILLA

Harvest House Villa, a property in Montego Bay Jamaica, is undergoing repairs in effort to host large foreign mission groups as well as pastoral retreats. Once complete, parties of 20-25 persons will be accommodated. FFMI utilizes this villa to create an experience intended to be part mission trip and part Caribbean vacation.

CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

Derval is a physically handicapped gentleman whose home is in disrepair. FFMI will be using this opportunity to share Christ's love and truth while helping Derval to repair his home.

Michael Sinclair is also on the construction list. He is currently homeless, although he works a full-time job as janitor and landscaper. Michael has secured a piece of land and FFMI missionaries are working on plans to erect a future home for him.
