

# **Frequently Asked Questions**

#### Who will perform my surgery?

Our surgeons are all board-certified in their specialities and practice at area hospitals.

#### How much will my surgery cost?

Every surgery at Epic has a fixed cost that is 50 to 90% lower than the price published by area hospitals. Prices are listed on our website and if you have questions, please give us a call.

#### What if I have insurance?

Epic is in-network with only a select group of insurers, but we might be your best option even if you have other insurance. A \$15,000 surgery bill combined with a \$5,000 deductible will still cost you \$7,000 if your insurance pays 80% of the cost once you've met your deductible.

Insurance drives up health care costs. Epic keeps cost low by participating with very few insurance plans. But because we are small, we are happy to work with you to get you the most benefit you can from your insurance.

#### What does the cost cover?

The Epic price covers everything needed on the day of surgery. This includes surgeon and anesthesia fees, medication, and facilities. You will not receive a bill from us for anything after the surgery. The cost does not cover imaging (MRI, x-ray, etc.) you may need before surgery or physical therapy you might need afterward.

#### What is the process for setting up surgery?

- 1. Make an appointment and get your questions answered.
- 2. Get any needed pre-surgical lab tests and imaging.
- 3. Schedule your surgery.
- 4. Meet with your surgeon for a pre-operative consultation and instructions.
- 5. Have your surgery.

## Foot/Toe Surgery
