FAMILY CONNECTION

Parent/Youth Discussion
Sunday, October 10

Use the following thoughts and questions to have a spiritual conversation as a family. Don't emphasize having the right answer, but focus on spending time discussing the Word as a family.

SCRIPTURE

Genesis 6:5-9, 13-14, 17-22; 8:15-16, 20-22; 9:1

SESSION SUMMARY

In this week's session, we looked at the story of Noah and the flood in Genesis 6-9. Since the fall, humanity's wickedness had spread and multiplied. In Genesis 6, God looked and saw that people had become wholly evil. Although God judged humanity, He saved Noah and his family, continuing His good purposes for people through them. Here are some of the main things we learned from the story:

- God declares judgment on humanity (Gen. 6:5-7)
- God provides a way to escape judgment (Gen. 6:8-9, 13-14, 17-22)
- God declares His blessing on humanity (Gen. 8:15-16, 20-22; 9:1)

CONVERSATION QUESTIONS

- Why is important for us to take our sin seriously?
- How can we walk with God even when others are walking in sin?
- What might it look like for us to remember that God's wrath has been removed and we have His blessing in Christ?

FAMILY CHALLENGE

Encourage each family member to research something related to the flood. It could be scientific, biblical (i.e. what the Bible says about the flood after Gen. 6-9), about rainbows and their cultural use or meaning over time, etc. Set aside a time to present and discuss your findings as a family.
