

FAMILY CONNECTION

Use the following thoughts and questions to have a spiritual conversation as a family. Don't emphasize having the right answer, but focus on spending time discussing the Word as a family.

SCRIPTURE

Genesis 10:32-11:4; Isaiah 65:1-2

SESSION SUMMARY

In this week's session, we looked at how sin is rebellion against God by considering the story of the tower of Babel in Genesis 11. Instead of spreading God's image and glory throughout creation, humanity joined together to defy God's command and exalt its own name. Here are some of the main things we learned from the story:

- Pride leads us to rebel against God's commands (Gen. 10:32-11:4)
- God's grace prevents us from ruining His plan (Gen. 11:5-9)
- God invites us to return to Him (Isa. 65:1-2)

CONVERSATION QUESTIONS

- · How does pride affect our relationship with God?
- How has God's grace intervened in our own lives?
- What are some things that keep us from returning to God?

FAMILY CHALLENGE

Encourage each person to research a engineering marvel (i.e. a skyscraper, dam, bridge, aircraft, etc.). At the end of the week, have each one share what he or she learned with the whole family. Then, discuss how we can use our abilities and accomplishments for God's glory and not our own.
