

Aspire Indiana Health is proud to partner with the U.S. Department of Labor on the Homeless Veterans' Reintegration Program (HVRP), the only federal grant focused exclusively on competitive employment for veterans experiencing homelessness.



The objectives of HVRP are to provide services to assist in reintegrating veterans experiencing homelessness into meaningful employment and to stimulate the development of effective service delivery systems that will address the complex problems facing homeless veterans.

Aspire's HVRP services are focused on employment and housing assistance for homeless veterans. A housing coordinator works with clients to find them a safe, stable, and affordable place to live.

Employment specialists work with clients every step of the way to assist in preparing for, obtaining and keeping employment. This includes create a resume, assist in job searching, interview preparation, on-site job coaching, and connecting veterans with other service providers.

Aspire HVRP services are paid for via grant and at no cost to qualifying veterans.

Am I eligible?

There is a four-part process to determining HVRP eligibility:

 Veteran status with at least one day of active duty and a

discharge other than dishonorable, AND

- Currently homeless or a participant in partner services such as SSVF or HUD-VASH
- Demonstrated need or would benefit from employment services.
