Please find attached an application for the **2021-2022 Farrington Foundation Scholarship Award**. This **\$5000** scholarship, sponsored by the Farrington Foundation, was established by Ethel Farrington, a former public health officer and author.

This scholarship requires applicants to be enrolled members of the Haliwa-Saponi Indian Tribe; be enrolled at least full time in a North Carolina State supported four year institution and attain and maintain a grade point average of **at least 3.0**. Students must have attended the fall semester and currently attending the spring semester of the current (2021-2022) school year. Funds will be distributed in \$2,500 increment distributions per semester for a total distribution of \$5,000 with your continued attendance at a four year institution during the 2022-2023 academic year. All funds will be available upon proof of enrollment and certification of grade point average.

The application must be submitted by **April 12, 2022 by 5:00pm**. You may mail the application to P.O. Box 99, Hollister, North Carolina 27844 or deliver it to the Chief W. R. Richardson Tribal Government Complex.

**Please follow all instructions and be sure you are submitting all required documents. Incomplete applications will not be considered.**
